The Lumpy skin disease (LSD) is emerging disease of cattle and buffaloes caused by Lumpy skin disease virus (LSDV). The disease in India is causing huge economic losses due to high mortality, morbidity which are leading to decreased production and reproduction and also movement and trade restrictions. The disease has spread like a wildfire within a span of three year from first report in 2019. Considering the impact of LSD on livestock, ICAR-NIVEDI in collaboration with Indian Virological Society (IVS) is organizing one day National Workshop in hybrid (physical and virtual) mode. During the workshop experts are invited to discuss on national status of disease in terms of epidemiology, vaccines, management etc., and future national control strategies and challenges. 
